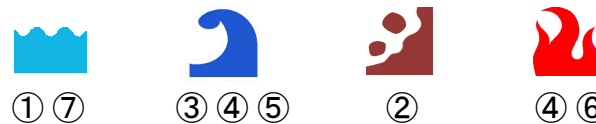


(Types of abnormal phenomena established in government ordinances, etc.)

- ① Flood
- ② Landslide, rocky mudflow, and landslip
- ③ High tide
- ④ Earthquake
- ⑤ Tsunami
- ⑥ Large-scale fire
- ⑦ Flooding due to inability to drain rainwater to sewers or other public water areas after temporary heavy rainfall
- ⑧ Volcanic phenomena occurring due to pyroclastic flow, lava flow, volcanic cinders, and other volcanic eruptions

Since it would be overly complicated to display on maps the symbols for all 8 of the disaster classifications, the disaster classifications have been arranged by taking into account the relevant forms of evacuation.

The symbols indicating disaster classifications for evacuation sites are the following four types. (Numbers in circles indicate the above-mentioned types ① to ⑦.)



Since the evacuation sites corresponding to ⑧ are limited to special regions, the disaster classifications are displayed in writing with pop-ups rather than by using symbols.
